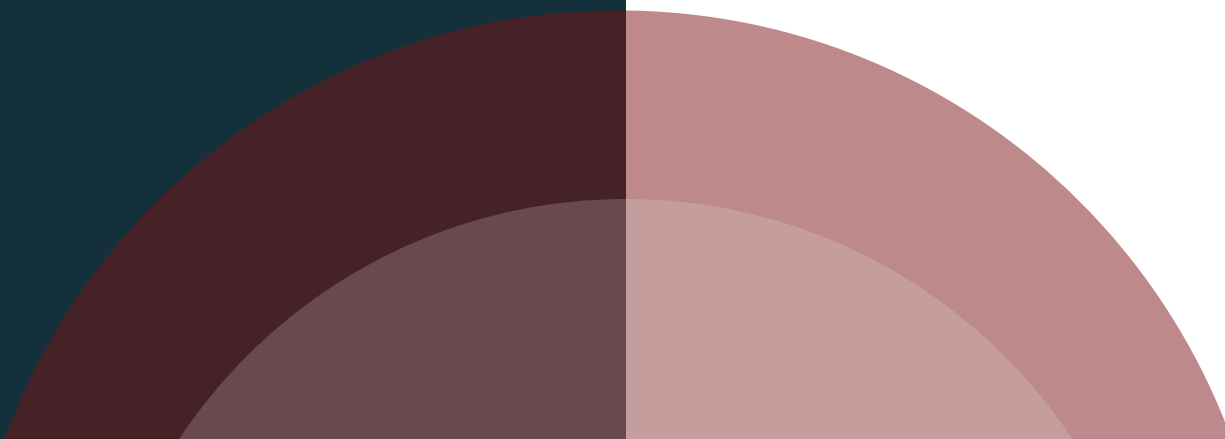
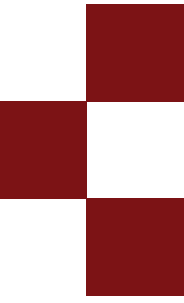
Leverage Networking Platforms

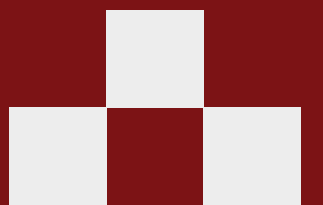



After meeting someone, always follow up with a personalized note or message. It's essential to maintain and nurture the connections you form, ensuring long-term benefits for both parties.




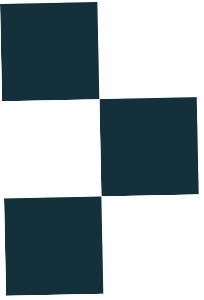
